Linkin – being respectful to his buddies in the playground.

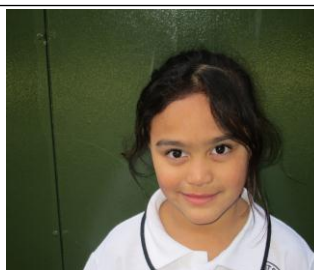
