### Little Achievers.

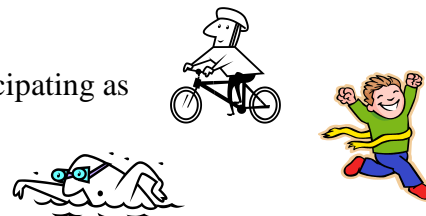
