Term 4 begins Monday 16th October 2017.

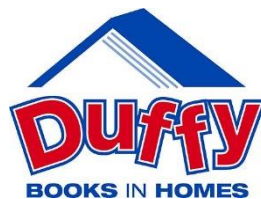
