Community Programme.

This term for the last hour of the day from Monday to Wednesday we are trialling our new curriculum initiative to ensure we are providing the children with a range of learning opportunities across a broad curriculum.

Our focus this term is Te Ao.

The students from Year 2 – 6 are being split into 6 groups and will be learning the following topics.

- Influential people in Maori History that helped shape NZ today.
- Te Ao kori – the world of movement – learning new hand/stick and string games.
- The History of the Patu – designing and creating.
- Kai – plant to table.
- Kinetic Art
- Tongaroa's Gift – responding to the legend in oral and visual form.
- Understanding the Korowai.

The Year 1 students will be taking part in:

Discovery learning – these activities have been chosen with specific purposes and skills in mind, such as fine motor (cutting, painting, drawing, making), imaginative play (dress-ups, play house), creative (blocks, construction, mobile etc.)

Being Active – Team games, being involved and actively participating is the main objective in this area.

Maths Discovery – this will involve risk-taking, working together and problem solving. There will be lots of hands on learning and discussion that will be taking place!

We are also linking in Te Ao Maori – the Maori World with some of the activities, to coincide with the programme the rest of the school is involved.
