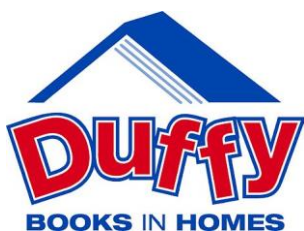
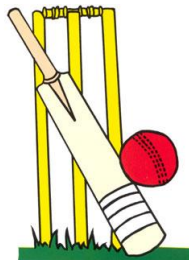
Rooms 1, 2, 3 & 4 will be having Cricket Skills from 9am to 10.am.
