The children will be working on their art for their calendar over the next few weeks. Calendars, cards or diaries can be ordered at the office. Order, with money by Friday 23rd November.

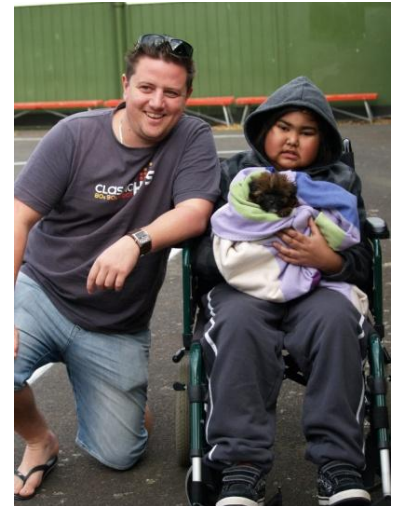
Working Bee.
