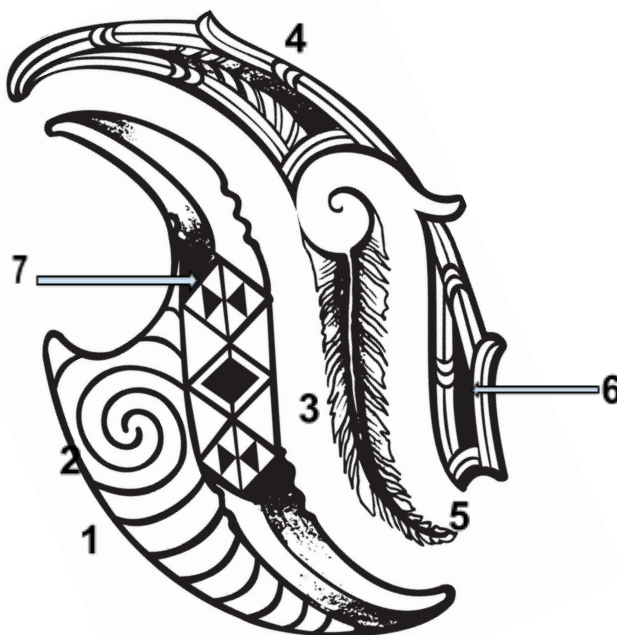


Anei te kōrero mo te tohu a Kapa Haka o Tōtara Puku
